Even being a modern city, Córdoba has many buildings dating from the Colonial times. The most remarkable ones are the Cabildo (town house) and the Cathedral in San Martín Square. The churches of the Company of Jesus, San Francisco and San Roque also deserve a visit.

The square and the Jesuitic Estancias, decleared Culture Mankind Patrimony by UNESCO are not to miss attractions. This city is also where the first Argentine National University was created.
